Each regional networking session will be hosted by a district that is currently "scaling-up" EIP district-wide. Take advantage of this opportunity to hear ideas from other teams about what works and how they have overcome various challenges.

Topics for discussion will be determined by the participants at each session and may include:

- identifying essential vs. non-essential information to be documented as part of an early intervention process;
- exploring how EIP is one of the foundational supports in a Response to Intervention (RTI) model;
- educating and involving all faculty in the early intervention process;
- partnering with families in the early intervention process;
- establishing coherence with other school priorities/initiatives; and
- examining key aspects of progress monitoring.
