

# **Six Approaches**


# **ONE TEACH, ONE OBSERVE**



#### WHY?

- To gather data
- To analyze data
- To check student progress
- To compare target students to others

### **TEAMING**



#### WHY?

 To demonstrate interaction to students (role playing, modeling)


### **PARALLEL TEACHING**



#### WHY?

- To lower student/teacher ratio
- To foster participation in discussions
- To monitor students more closely

# **ONE TEACH, ONE ASSIST**



#### WHY?

- To provide unobtrusive assistance to all students as needed
- One teacher has a particular area of expertise

### **ALTERNATIVE TEACHING**



#### WHY?

- If a small group of students needs remediation
- For enrichment
- For assessment purposes
- If mastery of a concept varies

## STATION TEACHING



#### WHY?

- To lower student/teacher ratio
- To teach several topics at once
- To teach complex material that is not hierarchical
